BACKGROUND TO ROMANS 9:17-18

* * * THE HARDENING OF PHARAOH'S HEART * * *

OBSERVATION: Scripture indicates Pharaoh hardened his own heart a multitude of times (perhaps as many as 7) before God is said to have hardened Pharaoh's heart, and Pharaoh did so in the context of unique, personal, and indisputably clear supernatural revelation from God. In a sense, this scenario is analogous to the unpardonable sin Jesus introduced when members of the Pharisees attributed His miracles to the power of Satan (cf. Matt12:24-32).

<u>LESSON</u>: God's proffered opportunity for obedience and/or repentance does not continue indefinitely. Clear revelation that is consistently rejected inevitably leads to a hardening of an individual's heart, and may result in God judicially and irreversibly hardening a person into a state of judgment (cf. Rom1:18-32).
