A Clear Allusion to a Pre-trib Rapture

(2 Thessalonians 2:1-2)

- ¹ Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,
- ² That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of the Christ⁴ is [present⁵].

Thus, the sense is:

We beseech you ... because of [the Rapture] ... that ye be not shaken in mind ... that the [Tribulation] is [present].
