

## ETYMOLOGY OF THE VERB "RAPTURE"

	<u>Verb</u>	<u>Verb Stem</u> <sup>1</sup>	<u>Definition</u>
Greek:	ῥαπαζω	ρπ (rp)	<i>to snatch away, to carry off, to seize hastily</i>
Latin:	rapio	rap	<i>to seize and carry off, to snatch</i>
English:	rapture	rap	<i>to seize by violence, to transport</i>

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<sup>1</sup> The verb stem is that part of the verb that remains constant in all of its inflected forms and carries the fundamental meaning of the verb.

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
