^{*}Jesus may have been born during the **Feast of Tabernacles** (cf. Lev23:34; Jn1:14; Rev21:3).

[†]It is possible Jesus was *conceived* on **December 25** (Luk1:35), which was the date of the winter solstice on the Julian calendar (cf. Ps19:4-6; Mal4:2); this would be the real miracle of Christmas, concerning which a multitude of pagan perversions abound (not vice-versa).
